

Pacific Jamboree is looking forward to welcoming 2200 Scouts and Scouters to Camp Barnard on July 6th. Please review the information below to travel to Camp Barnard.

Participant Ferry Check-In Procedure

Please arrive at the Tsawwassen Mills Mall Check-In area 2 hours prior to your ferry departure. This will give your group enough time for your youth to unload private vehicles and place it in the gear truck scheduled for your ferry.

Walk-on ferry check-in is at Tsawwassen Mills Shopping Mall, 5000 Canoe Pass Way, Delta, in the parking area 2G & 2H. Enter Tsawwassen Mills through Gate 2, off Highway 17. At Saks off Fifth Ave & Tommy Hilfiger, turn left. The Check-In Area is in front of Montana's restaurant. If you have gear, use the signed 'immediate unloading' area. If you are dropping off passengers, please park in the regular stalls and meet your group.

Participants will load the designated cargo truck with your camping equipment, tents, canopies, and camping backpacks. Please label your items with your unit number and subcamp colour. Please refer to your subcamp newsletter for camp colour coding. Camp fuel or propane is not permitted in the cargo trucks or on BC Ferries. All gear will be unloaded at the same drop-off area at Camp Barnard. Many bags look similar, please include your contact info on the item. Participants may carry a small daypack on the ferry/bus with them.

Contact Scouters can pick up their pre-paid ferry vouchers from a PJ Rep at the red canopy. The voucher cannot be replaced if lost or stolen. Keep the voucher in a safe place, you will require it for return ferry travel!

Once all equipment and camping backpacks are on the cargo trucks, please walk to the special PJ Shuttle Bus loading zone. Board one of the special transit busses for the 10 min drive to the ferry terminal.

Contact Scouters exchange their travel voucher with the BC Ferries ticket agent for boarding passes. Each walk-on traveler must have a boarding pass. **Walk-on passengers must have a boarding pass and be inside the terminal 30 min prior to your sailing.** This is different than the posted BC Ferries walk-on passenger cut-off times.

Enjoy the hour and thirty-minute sailing to Swartz Bay. Scouters are responsible for their patrol.

In Swartz Bay, exit the foot passenger terminal and turn right. Wilson's Transportation busses will be waiting for travelers.

Participant Airport Arrivals

Welcome to Victoria, BC!

Please collect your luggage, gather your group, and use the facilities if necessary. Please exit the terminal and turn right. The PJ Bus will pick up your group outside. Please exit the terminal quickly so other travelers don't get delayed.

****PLEASE NOTE**** – Groups may have to split up due to seating configurations on the bus.

Luggage will be loaded into the cargo area under the bus, or on a designated PJ Truck. Please label your items with your unit number and subcamp colour. Please refer to your subcamp newsletter for camp colour coding

The drive to camp is approximately 1 hour and 30 min. Busses will unload at the bus loop inside Camp Barnard. If your gear is under the bus, please collect it immediately. If the gear was loaded on a PJ Truck, it will be available for pickup on the road to Sub Camps. Backpacks and luggage may look similar. Please ensure you take the correct bag.

Private Vehicle Arrivals

Camp Barnard is located at 3202 Young Lake Rd, Sooke. It is approximately an hour drive from the airport, and an hour and half from BC Ferries Swartz Bay terminal.

Private Vehicle Parking & Arrivals is Open 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM, Saturday, July 6th

All participants arriving by private vehicle (except private charter bus) are required to park & unload or drop off passengers at the PJ Off-Site Parking Lot. The lot is located 2810 Ramsden Rd, Sooke. Please follow the direction of volunteers. Park close to the vehicles around you in order to allow parking for all groups.

Please unload camping and personal gear from your private vehicles and reload it onto a PJ truck. Please label your items with your unit number and subcamp colour. Please refer to your subcamp newsletter for camp colour coding. Gear will be available for pickup on the road to Sub Camps. Propane and camp fuel will be transported by PJ for this short drive.

After all your gear is on the PJ truck, take the shuttle van to camp. It will drop you at the Bus Loop. Go to registration and then collect your camp gear.

All vehicles parked at PJ are left at the owner's risk. The parking lot will not be patrolled.

If you are driving to camp, please arrive between 9 am and 4 pm.

Private Charter Bus Arrival

Any groups that have organized arrival by private bus must seek permission to drop off at camp from [Scott Alsop](#), PJ Transport Manager. The contact Scouter and charter bus company name will be given to the gatehouse. Your bus will be permitted to drive to the bus loop inside Camp Barnard. Please unload your gear quickly to allow other PJ busses to unload. The loop only allows one bus to unload at a time.
